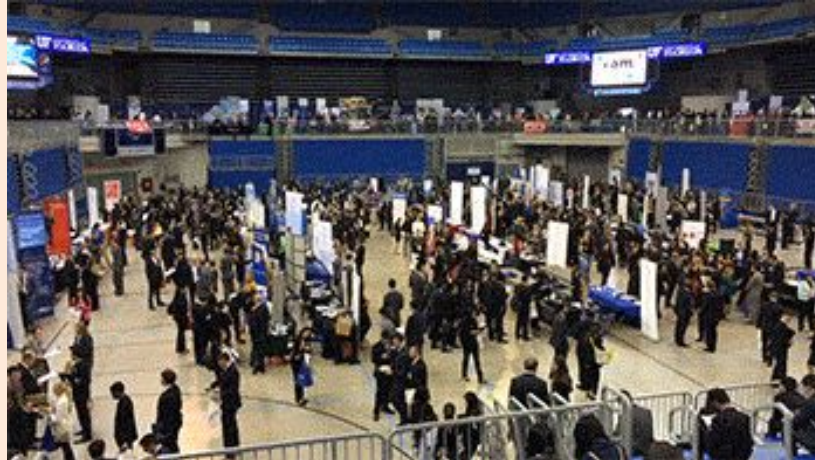






# What is Career Showcase?

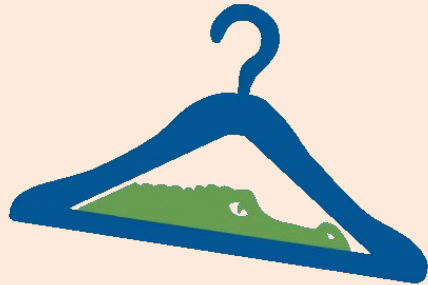

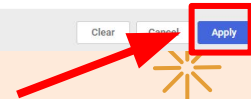

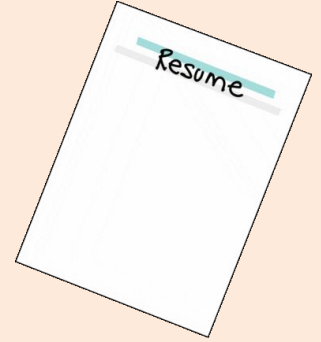

# Resume



Get your Resume snappy and ready!

- 1 Page Resume!
- Print Resume at the Reitz Union Student Government Copy Center for free with FANCY paper.
  - Usually occurs a week or two before showcase
  - No need for fancy parchment paper
- If services are backed up, the other (paid) option is Target Copy on University. Simply email yourself a copy of your resume, go to the store to feel and choose what kind of paper you'd like, open up your pdf and print it there!
- SASE will be hosting resume reviews through our Resume + Mock Interview hours in the coming weeks!

# Talking to Recruiters

## Elevator Pitch

Explaining who you are to a recruiter / cluing them in on why they would want to hire you, in the time it takes to ride an elevator.

## Back and Forth with Recruiters

- S : Situation
  - Describe the situation
- T : Task
  - Describe the task
- A : Action
  - Action you took to solve
- R : Result
  - Describe the result in terms of benefits

# Ask Questions



- The recruiter will ask if you have any questions at the end
- **Always** ask questions!
  - What do you like about working for [company]?
  - How would you describe the work culture?
  - What differs a good intern from a great intern?
- Tip: If there is a company you really want to get an internship at, research them quickly before the career fair so you can create very specific questions and impress them! If you applied beforehand, you can ask about the process!

And then... walk away knowing you did a great job, maybe with an interview scheduled!







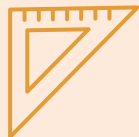
# General Tips

- Apply to the company **before** you go to the career fair
- Remember to get contact information from recruiters you speak to at the career fair, so that you can contact recruiters after
- Be confident!
- Go to get some company merch
- It's always good to have name tag!
  - Woah SASE is having a name tag?
- Reminder, we're going to go more into depth with all of this stuff at our interview prep and resume workshop next week, and our resume hours next week to help you create and edit your resumes!
