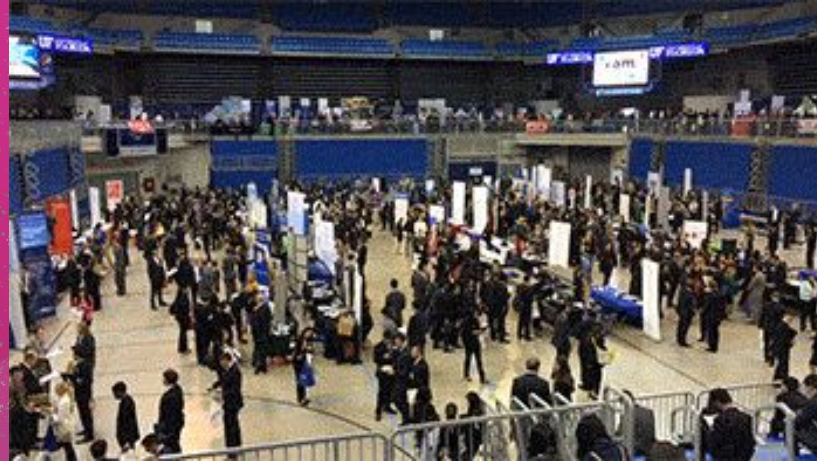


What is an internship?

- **Internships** are temporary work opportunities with companies or organizations
 - Work within a professional team on a project
 - Typically 10-12 weeks during the summer
- Internships can benefit you and your career
 - Gain professional and technical experience
 - Get paid!

What is Career Showcase?

- **UF Career Fair**
 - Offers students the **opportunity** to find internships, part-time, full-time, and co-op opportunities
 - Meet professional recruiters in-person



Why should I attend?

- Career fairs are a great way to:
 - Learn more about internship opportunities
 - Network with recruiters and companies
 - Practice communicating with professionals
- First-years can benefit from attending career fairs too!
 - Internship opportunities
 - Gain experience networking
 - Learn about different companies

When is Career Showcase?

General Flow of Showcase

Steps to being successful at showcase!

1. Line up to talk to companies at their booths
2. Hand your resume to a recruiter
3. Introduce yourself and give your elevator pitch

Elevator Pitch

- Named after the time it takes to ride up/down an elevator
- Brief introduction about yourself, why you want to work for their company and why they should hire you (skills, experience, etc.)
 - 30 seconds to 1 minute
- One of your first interactions with a recruiter
 - Practice, practice, practice!

Talking to Recruiters

After introducing yourself and providing your information, learn more about your potential job

- Talk about what you know about the company
 - Previous research about the company stands out!
- Talk about the field you want to work in
- Show interest in the conversation
- Approach the conversation normally
 - Be confident!

5. Ask questions about the company/positions they have

Asking Questions

Take this time to learn more about the company you're applying to:

- Application process
- Available positions
- Workload/projects

Make an impact on the recruiter with thoughtful questions:

- Ask about company projects or products that interest you
- Ask about their work/accomplishments/why they work for the company

General Tips

- Apply to the company **before** you go to the career fair
- Remember to get contact information from recruiters you speak to at the career fair, so that you can contact recruiters after
- Be confident!
- Go to get some company merch
- It's always good to have a name tag!
