STAR METHOD

01

SITUATION

Describe the specific situation or problem you faced.

03

ACTION

Detail the actions you took to address the situation or complete the task.

02


TASK

Explain the task or objective you needed to accomplish.

04

RESULT

Share the outcome of your actions, including any lessons learned/achievements.



STAR EXAMPLE

- Tell me about a time you learned a new skill, and how you applied it.
- Situation (S): During my past internship, I had to learn how to use the VueJS framework.
- **Task (T):** I **needed to implement** a dropdown component on a web application that connected an object's properties to the dropdown's list.
- Actions (A): Because I was entirely unfamiliar with VueJS, I began my progress by watching VueJS tutorials on Youtube and looked over similar examples of VueJS being used in the repository. If I had any questions after doing my own research about implementation and specific naming conventions for the company's code, I would compile a list of questions I had to ask my mentor during our 1:1 meeting.
- Results (R): After following VueJS tutorial to become familiar with the framework and asking
 my mentor some clarifying questions, I was able to fully implement a working dropdown
 component and merged it into master before the Sprint ended.





GENERAL INTERVIEW TIPS


- Understand the company's mission, values, products, and recent developments.
- KNOW YOUR RESUME!!
- Dress professionally, considering the company culture and industry.
- Be attentive and listen actively. (Avoid "um" or "like")
- Prepare thoughtful questions about the company, role, or team.
- Follow up with a thank-you email.





PHONE US VIRTUAL US IN-PERSON INTERVIEWS





- Speak clearly and concisely.
- Take brief pauses before answering.
- Write down any important info







- Choose a quiet, well-lit location.
- Dress professionally, maintain good posture.
- Maintain eye contact with the camera and SMILE.





- Arrive slightly early.
- Demonstrate good body language.
- Bring resume/portfolio
- Put devices on silent



COMMON INTERVIEW QUESTIONS

If your group member answers a question well, then your team wins a point!

- Can you tell me about a strength and a weakness you possess?
- Please share a brief introduction about yourself.
- Why are you interested in this position/this job?
- Why should we hire you for this role?

- Can you provide an example of how you have resolved conflicts with others or handled team projects?
- How do you approach problem-solving and meeting deadlines while managing stress?
- How do you keep yourself organized in your work?
- What questions do you have for us?





