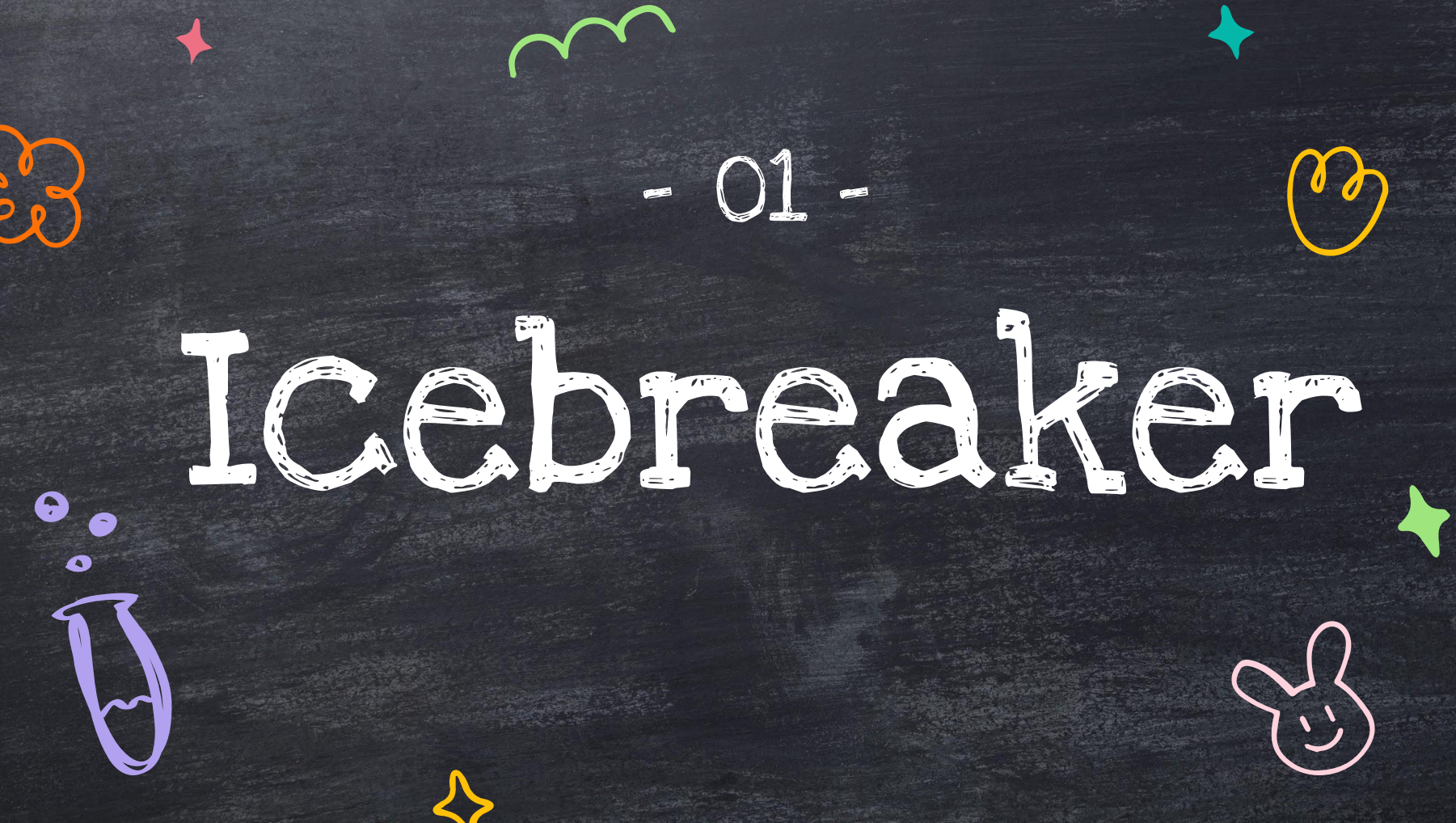





Elevator pitch

- Named after the time it takes to ride up/down an elevator
- Brief introduction about yourself, why you want to work for their company and why they should hire you (skills, experience, etc.)
 - 30 seconds to 1 minute
 - Make sure to mention the kind of position you are looking for and when!
- One of your **first** interactions with a recruiter
 - Practice, practice, practice!

Our tips!

Research + Prep!

Learn more about the company you're applying to:

- Application process
- Available positions
- Workload/projects

Apply to the company **BEFORE** you go to the career fair

Make Questions!

- Ask about company projects or products
- Ask about their work, accomplishments, why they work there

At Career Showcase:

Go **EARLY**, lines can get long!

Go with friends: it makes it so much more enjoyable :)

Warm up by talking to some companies you aren't as interested in

When talking to a company:

- Introduce yourself and provide your pitch + resume
- Talk about what you know about the company, the field you want to work in & how they relate!
- Show interest in the company, be confident and excited!


It's important to remember that **recruiters are people too**

Go to get some company merch and swag bags

It's always good to have a name tag!

After Showcase:

Remember to get contact information from recruiters you speak to at the career fair, so that you can follow up with them after



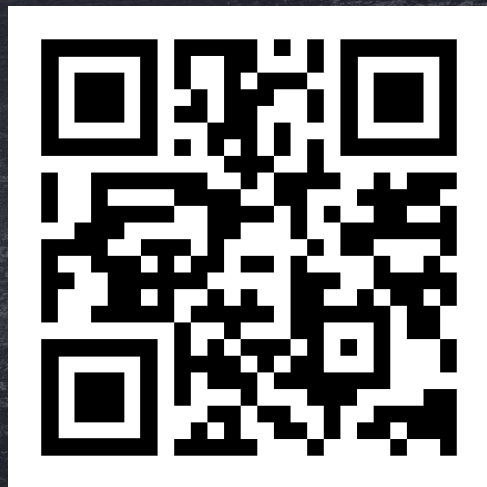

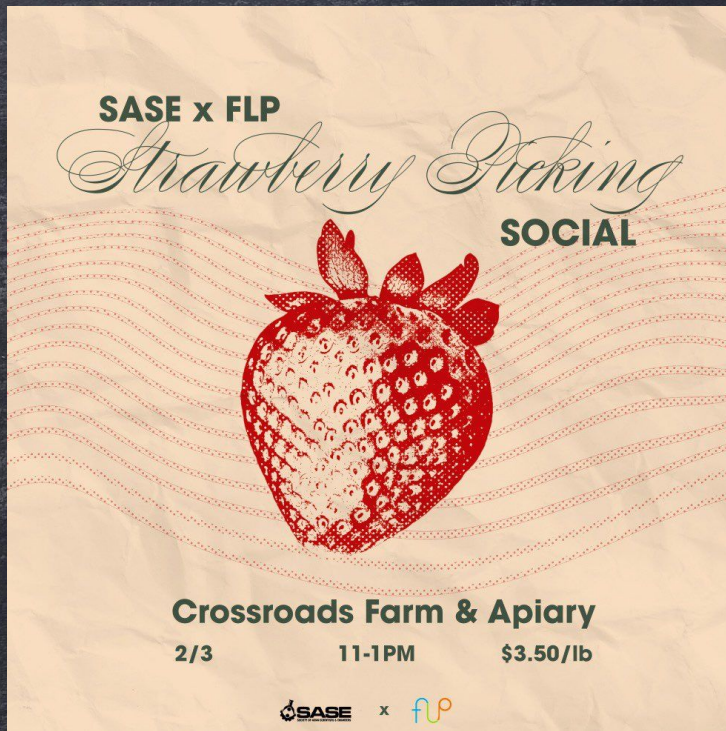
